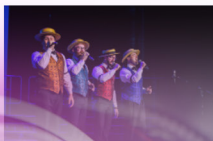

The Society's outreach to the music education community is never ending. We need funding to help Music Educators join us at Harmony University as an extension of their required Continuing Education requirement, to learn more about barbershop harmony and how it can impact their choral programs.

In addition, music educators learn how the BHS community truly cares and supports the growing challenges and needs of choral music in our schools. This is our way of giving back to the music educators who influenced our lives in our journey by planting the seeds of choral music impact ... and maybe a tag or two!

"We can never know just how far-reaching the impact of barbershop will have on a school program or on a student's life. Recently, I reconnected with a teacher in Portugal whose class received a practical demonstration on barbershop from me five years ago. Five years later, I find out that this chorus insists on singing a tag at the end of every rehearsal and won't leave until it rings!

That one brief experience with education on barbershop translated to hundreds of tags sung by hundreds of students in a country where barbershop hasn't even really been established! **Think of what can be done if educators like my friend could attend HU and really get the tools needed for including barbershop in their programs.** Donating to music education outreach at HU will allow more experiences with barbershop, greater experiences with harmony, and will help us to keep the whole world singing. Let's start with the teachers in our own backyard."

Determining Relative Rank

Music

Music is defined as the song and arrangement, as performed. The Music Category judges the arranger's skill and the performer's musicianship in bringing the mood or story of the song to life, and the suitability of the material to the barbershop style.

Performance

These judges evaluate how effectively a performer brings the song to life. They judge the entertainment value of the performance — the *art* of the performance.

Singing

In the Singing Category, artistic singing in the barbershop style is judged — listening holistically for ringing in-tune voices that use a free, beautiful and rich vocal quality, which is wonderfully unified and vocally expressive.

Each judge may award up to 100 points per song.

The amount of analog video and audio footage and photography just sitting in the BHS basement Archives is absolutely staggering. It's one of those things where you actually have to walk into the Archives and see it for yourself to get an idea of exactly how vast the collection of nearly a century's worth of priceless Barbershop history truly is. Visitors to the Archives are greeted with shelves upon shelves of huge arrays of assets in a wide variety of formats. There are reel-to-reel videos and magnetic audio tape, obscure tape deck formats, cassettes, vinyls, binders full of photo film negatives, slides, and even audio formats like wax cylinders, all of which are essentially unplayable without the proper equipment.

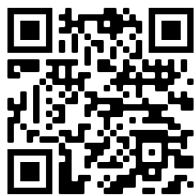
Adding to the complexity of digitizing these assets is the limited shelf-life of a considerably large

portion of our reel-to-reel video footage. As film ages it can become brittle and can easily crack. We are basically in a race against time.

Thanks to generous donations from our 17 Districts for the 2020 Legacy Quartet Contest, we were able to acquire the resources to restore a considerable amount of priceless, never-before-seen footage dating back well into the 1940s, but even this relatively large-scale project barely scratched the surface.

The overwhelmingly positive response from those who enjoyed the Legacy Quartet Contest event showed us just how valuable bringing our incredible history back to life in fully-restored high-resolution glory is.
