Description

We are seeking an intern who can participate in various stages of product development, including music licensing (copyright), sheet music editing, and creating/updating product profiles in our online store.

The intern should be prepared to work in a team-oriented environment, and will finish the internship having gained broad experience in various aspects of music publishing, specifically related to print music product creation/updating, retail website backend, and music licensing.

- Assist Copyright and Licensing department with music licensing of retail sheet music and audio products.
- Create and update retail product profiles in online store (website backend).
- Update music files with new copyright notices.
- Assist with July Harmony University event (if applicable).
- Additional tasks and projects as directed by the Copyright & Licensing Manager.
